### INVITATION FOR BID

1. The Government of Tanzania has set aside funds for the operations of the **National Examinations Council of Tanzania** during the financial year **2009/2010**. It is intended that part of the proceeds of the fund will be used to cover eligible payment under the contract for the **Supply and Installation of machines**
2. The **National Examinations Council of Tanzania** now invites sealed bids from eligible Suppliers for **Supply and Installation of machines**:

Bidding will be conducted through the **International Competitive Bidding** procedures specified in the Public Procurement (Goods, Works, Non Consultant Service and Disposal of Public Assets by Tender) Regulations, 2005 – Government Notice No. 97 and are open to all Bidders as defined in the Regulations.
4. Interested and eligible Bidders may obtain further information from and inspect the Bidding Documents at the office of the Secretary to the Tender Board of the **National Examinations Council of Tanzania, Room number 126 Stores Building, P.O Box 2624, Dar es Salaam** from **8.30 to 4.30 pm** on Mondays to Fridays inclusive except on public holidays.
5. A complete set of Bidding Document(s) in English and additional sets may be purchased by interested Bidders on the submission of a written application to the address given under paragraph 4 above and upon

- payment of a non-refundable fee of Tanzanian shillings one hundred thousand (Tshs **100,000/=**) only. Payment should either be by Cash, Banker's Draft, or Banker's Cheque, payable to Executive Secretary National Examinations Council of Tanzania.
6. All Bids must be accompanied by a Bid security of **two percent (2%)** of the contract price in an acceptable form or freely convertible currencies in case of foreign Bidders.
  7. All bids in one original plus two copies, properly filled in, and enclosed in plain envelopes and clearly marked "**The Tender Number and Descriptions of the particular Tender**", not to be opened before **14:30hrs on 2<sup>nd</sup> November, 2009**. Bids will be opened promptly thereafter in public and in the presence of Bidders' representatives who choose to attend in the opening ceremony at the **Conference Room Number 117, Ground Floor -Administration Building at National Examinations Council of Tanzania**.
  8. Late Bids, Portion of Bids, Electronic Bids, Bids not received, Bids not opened and not read out in public at the bid opening ceremony shall not be accepted for evaluation irrespective of the circumstances.
